The Runnymede Gallery officially opened on Sat 7th November 2009 and will be open weekends during the Winter months with extended hours over the Summer.

Winter: Sats & Suns 11am to 4.30pm

Summer: Thurs to Mons (including Bank Holidays) 11am to 4.30pm

The gallery is in an enviable position, alongside the busy A308, with 3 gallery rooms to view and with an artist in residence in his studio. And opposite are the Magna Carta Tea Rooms, making a visit to Runnymede a great day out over the long Winter months.



Runnymede, being of such historic importance and for the Kennedy and Air Force Memorials, brings thousands of visitors during the Summer months. There are also lovely meadow walks alongside the River Thames, leisurely river trips available from the boatyard next to the gallery and interesting events for all the family held by The National Trust.

Artists Exhibiting Information

There are two gallery rooms for hire at the Runnymede Gallery. Artists may hold solo or group exhibitions. A few 3D spaces, with plinths, are available. There is also a browser and a card stand for artist's greetings cards.

Artists can hold a Private View for their exhibition and change the artwork in their allotted 'space' at any time by arrangement with Gary Rogers, the Manager and resident artist at the gallery.

During the Winter months the artists do not need to steward their exhibitions as this will be done by the gallery manager Gary Rogers. As the gallery is open longer over the Summer months the artist's will have to be available for some stewarding of their own exhibitions during these months.

The Runnymede Gallery does a great deal of marketing such as leaflets, press releases and on their website for the all the exhibitions but exhibiting artists are also expected to promote their own exhibitions. A list of press publications and contacts will be supplied with each booking. During their exhibition all exhibiting artists will be mentioned on the gallery website with a link back to their own websites.
